Applicants must serve the greater Park Slope community and must be non-profit organizations whose services, programs and projects are open to residents of Park Slope.
- 2. Funds are not provided for operating costs of ongoing programs or infrastructure projects.
- 3. Grant monies must be used within one year from the date of award.
- 4. Organizations that have received more than three grants from the Park Slope Civic Council over the past five years will not be eligible.
- 5. Applications must be received by December 13, 2019 and grants will be awarded in February 2020.
